COVERAGE OF NOTABLE CRIMINAL CASES

Adnan Syed – Subject of first *Serial* podcast

- Seema led MSNBC's coverage of the Syed case in 2015.
- Seema hosted and produced two specials for MSNBC.com with Syed's lawyers and evidentiary experts – the live streams had more viewers than cable in those hours.
- Seema covered Syed's hearing for a new trial (Feb. 2016) as a freelance journalist using Twitter and Youtube to break news and give live updates to tens of thousands across the globe.
- Syed's brother gave his first interview to Seema.
- Seema was the first to reveal several witnesses would be testifying before they took the stand.

Harvey Weinstein

- Seema led Court TV's coverage of the Weinstein trial in Manhattan.
- Exclusive interviews of several victims and expert witnesses prior to trial.
- Secured first interview with Weinstein's legal team.
- Broke news of Weinstein admitted to hospital prior to trial.
- Broke news of Weinstein's change in bail condition.
- Broke news that Rosie Perez would be testifying before other networks reported.
- Broke news that a verdict had been reached before verdict was read in courtroom.

Robert Durst – Subject of HBO's *The Jinx*

- First to report backgrounds and make up of jury on Court TV.
- Broke news for Court TV that trial was suspended due to Covid.
- First journalist to receive prosecutor's entire file.

Dan Markel – Subject of first *Over My Dead Body* podcast

- Seema led Court TV's coverage by preparing anchors, correspondents, and producers with background on this complicated legal scandal involving five years of investigations into seven suspects that led to a trial of two defendants.
- Seema exclusively interviewed the victim's (Florida law professor) best friend on Court TV.
- Seema led the breaking news verdicts.

Dr. Jeffrey MacDonald – Subject of 1984 NBC miniseries *Fatal Vision*

- One of the most litigated cases in history; Seema covers MacDonald's legal battles for FOX46 Charlotte.
- In an exclusive, Seema interviewed MacDonald's lawyer from his 1979 trial during MacDonald's April 2021 hearing in Raleigh, NC.
- Seema broke the news that MacDonald was denied compassionate release.
