- Lead reporter on Surfside condo collapse investigation. Matched thousands of photos and videos to building plans and other public records to identify problems. Worked with engineers to produce a finite element analysis and 3D animators to visualize the findings.
- Used social media, time-stamped photos and video to show how police started the violence at a BLM protest in Fort Lauderdale, FL, leading to the resignation of the chief who had blamed protesters. Analyzed munitions found on the scene and showed police violated internal training protocols regarding "less lethal" weapons. [How FLPD started violence at BLM protest](#)
- Managed public records requests and produced competitive stories about the migrants flown to Martha's Vineyard by Gov. Ron DeSantis. Traveled to San Antonio, TX, quickly built sources, and exclusively reported on migrants awaiting the next flight in a hotel.
- Used photos and on-the-ground reporting to show the Honduran Military Police were killing protesters with U.S. weapons, in violation of arms transfer agreements.
- Lead investigative data reporter during the COVID-19 pandemic. Supplemented investigations with interactive and static data visualizations/ maps.

- Used satellite data, social media posts and drone footage to expose one of Central America's largest fleets fishing sharks with vulnerable laborers in the Eastern Pacific. Produced a 30-minute podcast for Reveal.
